Safety First

- This product is designed for snorkeling purposes only. Do not use for any other purpose.
- Always inspect product and parts before every use. If you find any cracks, punctures, irregularities, or any other damage, do not use.
- Do not dive face-first into water, as this may shatter the mask, which may cause serious injury.
- Do not scuba dive, free dive, or perform intensive swimming with this product. This product is not designed for such strenuous breathing activities.
- Do not disassemble, modify, attach unauthorized accessories, or attempt repair of any product or part, as this may lead to serious injury, accidents and will void your warranty.
- If you experience any dizziness, light-headedness, or shortness of breath while using the product, stop using immediately.
- KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. This product is not intended for use of children under 12 years of age. Adult supervision is advised.

Precautions

- Before every use, check that there is no sand or other debris on or in the Snorkel Mask and Breathing Tube. If you find any sand or debris, rinse with water.
- Always perform a Seal Test to check the quality of the leak-proof seal. For more detailed instructions please see the Seal Check section.

INSTRUCTIONS

Attaching the Breathing Tube

1. Hold the Breathing Tube so it is oriented as seen in **Figure B**.
2. To attach, slide the Breathing Tube over the tube mount on top of the Snorkel Mask. Be sure you are not attaching it to the GoPro Mount.

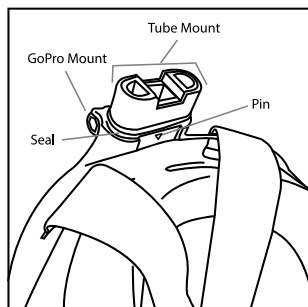

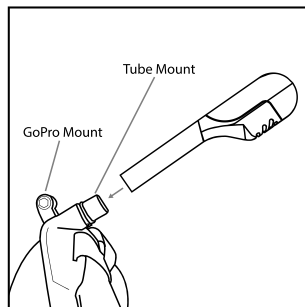

3. Push the Breathing Tube in until the pin locks into place.
4. Tug the Breathing Tube to test if it is firmly in place. The Breathing Tube should COMPLETELY cover the seal and be flush against the Snorkel Mask, as seen in **Figure D**.

DO NOT push with excessive force when attaching the Breathing Tube to the Snorkel Mask, as this may affect the leak-proof seal .

If you are having trouble attaching the Breathing Tube and Snorkel Mask, there may be sand or debris present. Rinse all parts and make sure there is no sand remaining, then try again.

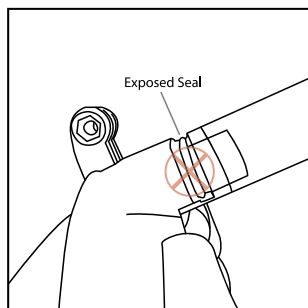

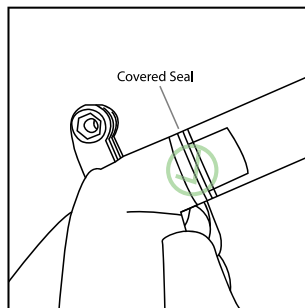

Putting on the Mask

1. Pull the straps of the Snorkel over your head. Test the fit of it over your face.
2. Adjust straps accordingly. It should fit snugly, but DO NOT over-tighten, as this may cut blood circulation.
3. **SEAL CHECK:**

- A. Perform a breathing seal check: With Snorkel on, breathe normally. If you feel a slight pressure change when you breathe, this indicates a good seal.
- B. Perform a water seal check: With the Snorkel on, carefully dip your face into the water. If water leaks into the mask, lift your face from the water and adjust the straps. Perform the water seal check and adjust as needed until no water leaks in.

*It is recommended to shave facial hair, which may affect the leak-proof seal performance. For those with long hair, ensure that no hair is trapped between your face and the mask.

HOW TO USE

1. When in the water, always breathe calmly through your mouth or nose.
2. For the easiest breathing, swim on the surface of the water and keep your chin slightly raised. DO NOT dive.
3. If at any time you feel shortness of breath, remove yourself from the water and remove mask immediately.
4. If you feel any obstructions in your breathing, this may mean that water has temporarily gotten in through the Snorkel. Some causes may be larger waves that get into the top of the snorkel, user leaning their head too far forward, or improper sizing or fitting.
 - A. The dry stop snorkel design prevents water from entering the TOP of the Snorkel.
 - B. If water leaks into the Snorkel, raise your head above water and allow the water to drain out through the one-way purge valve, located on the chin part of the mask. This way, you will not have to remove the mask to drain water.

CARE & STORAGE

- After every use, wash thoroughly with fresh water.
- You may use a mild detergent to clean the mask. Be sure to rinse off completely. Do not use harsh cleaning agents or abrasives.
- Wipe dry with a soft towel or cloth to prevent water spots. Allow to dry completely before storing.
- Store in a dry, cool environment. Do not store in direct sunlight or high heat.
- To best preserve the clarity and quality of your Snorkel Mask's, do not place face down on any surface, as this may damage the viewing window.
- Avoid leaving the Snorkel Mask and Breathing Tube in sandy areas or environments where debris can get in the parts and affect the leak-proof seal.
- Color from other items may transfer to the silicone parts. When storing, keep away from colored items.

WARRANTY INFORMATION

Our product is guaranteed to be free from manufacturing defects for a period of 12 Months.

If your product becomes defective during this period, Electus Distribution will repair, replace, or refund where a product is faulty; or not fit for intended purpose.

This warranty will not cover modified product; misuse or abuse of the product contrary to user instructions or packaging label; change of mind and normal wear and tear.

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and failure does not amount to a major failure.
